The family of the Reverend W. Irving Monroe, Jr. has established a scholarship to honor his memory and his ministry and to provide assistance for future ministers. A graduate of the Class of 1938 at Andover Newton Theological School, Reverend Monroe served Congregational and United Church of Christ congregations for more than 60 years. He also served as chaplain to several Massachusetts fire departments and to the Masons. This memorial scholarship is administered by the Trustees of the Grand Council of Royal and Select Master Masons of Massachusetts.

Special Condition of Award: The Monroe Memorial Scholarship is awarded each fall, and the student award recipient(s) must attend the spring banquet, in southeastern Massachusetts, of the Grand Council of Royal and Select Master Masons of Massachusetts. Logistical arrangements in connection with event details and participation are the responsibility of the student awardee(s).
