



## WHAT'S HAPPENING AT THE LIBRARY?

In preparation for the possible move of other library collections into the Trask library building, the staff has started a major collection evaluation project of both journal and book material. This project will continue during the academic year.

### Journals

We have removed from the collection all print journals which are available full text in ATLAS or EBSCO Religion and Philosophy; use the Databases link at the library web page. Many of these titles will be shipped to seminary libraries in Africa, Asia, Eastern Europe, Latin America, and the Middle East.

If you have a question about full text availability for a specific title, use the E-Journal List link at the library web page. E-journals are also listed in the web catalog with a direct URL link to the e-journal list.

### Books

In May we began evaluation of pre-1973 books in the Cutter section on the lower level, including the subject areas of philosophy, ethics, comparative religion, psychology, Bible, theology, history, and Christian education. The lower level stacks area is closed for public use. If you are looking for books in the call number range of A-DD45/G, please ask a staff member for help.
