

INSTRUCTIONS AND GUIDELINES INTERNATIONAL STUDENT SCHOLARSHIPS

A Scholarship Application Form must be submitted only if you are interested in being considered for scholarship assistance. **In order for your scholarship application to be considered, your admissions application must be complete, and you must have been accepted for admission to the School.** Scholarship Applications are due April 1 each year. Notification of awards will be made in May or June. If any of the information you provide on this Scholarship Application Form changes, all updated materials must be submitted by this date.

The amount of scholarship aid available from Andover Newton is limited and if received, only covers tuition expenses. Even if a scholarship is granted, applicants should still expect to pay between 65% and 85% of all estimated educational and living expenses. Therefore, you are expected to be able to provide most of your own financial resources. (See the back side of International Student Application Policies & Procedure sheet for approximate expenses.)

The following guidelines are used by the International Student Scholarship Committee to recommend scholarships for some international applicants:

- **Clarity of educational objectives**
This should be demonstrated in the essay required with your admissions application.
- **Financial and personal/moral support from your home church and denomination for pursuing theological education in the United States**
Financial support from your church or denomination should be demonstrated on your Financial Guarantee Form, or through other written documentation provided with this scholarship application. Personal and moral support should be demonstrated through letters of recommendation and institutional endorsements, or on the attached Scholarship Application Form.
- **Realistic strategy for managing educational, financial and family obligations during your program of study at Andover Newton**
On the attached Scholarship Application Form, please provide information about how you plan to pay for your education as well as take care of your family's financial and personal needs, and how your family will be supported in your home country if they do not join you at Andover Newton.
- **Ability to write and speak English**
This should be demonstrated with a satisfactory TOEFL score and in the essay required with your admissions application.
- **Familiarity with cultures other than one's own**
This may be demonstrated in your essay or in letters of recommendation, but if not, please provide information on the attached Scholarship Application Form.
- **Country of origin**
Preference is given to applicants from non-first world countries.
